
Overview






Our Construction and Development DPS connects our customers to experienced contractors ready to deliver their new build projects. It's a compliant route to appoint contractors to deliver the build stage, once all previous stages of design and planning have been approved. This DPS covers the whole of England.

DPS Summary

The DPS covers site preparation and construction. It's designed to help customers to develop a range of property types – houses, flats, sheltered accommodation, commercial and communal facilities, corporate property or similar buildings.

The DPS is divided into five lots. It's been split into value bands designed to suit all project requirements – from smaller sites to projects over £50m. We also have a separate Lot that covers site preparation.

Step One

Step Five

Choose which Lot(s) you'd like to apply for and which regions you work in and submit your response.

Step Six

We'll review your submission within 10 working days. If successful, you'll be asked to sign the DPS Agreement. Once this has been signed and returned you'll be added to the DPS and will be able to take part in future related tender opportunities
